Take a trip around the world this summer at the Minot Public Library. Everyone can see the world by participating in the 2011 summer reading program.

Reading takes you places that you've only dreamed about. Children who read a minimum of thirty minutes per week will be eligible for weekly drawings that will be held throughout the summer. Children signing up for the program will be given a passport to keep track of the time they spend reading each week. They will be given one chance to win for each symbol crossed off the passport. Children will also be given a chance to win each time they check out materials.

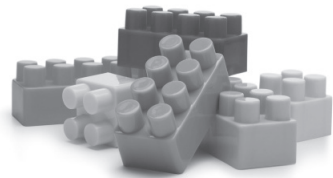

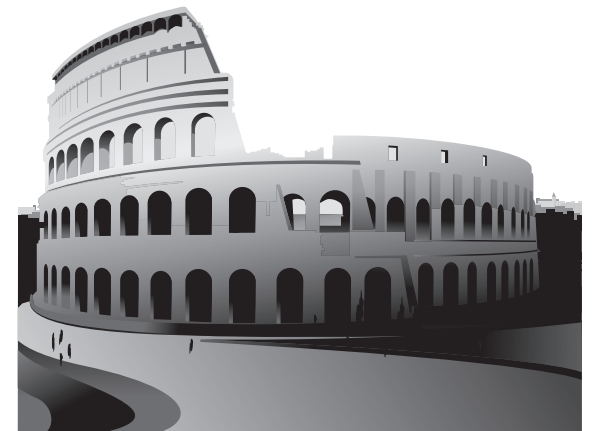
