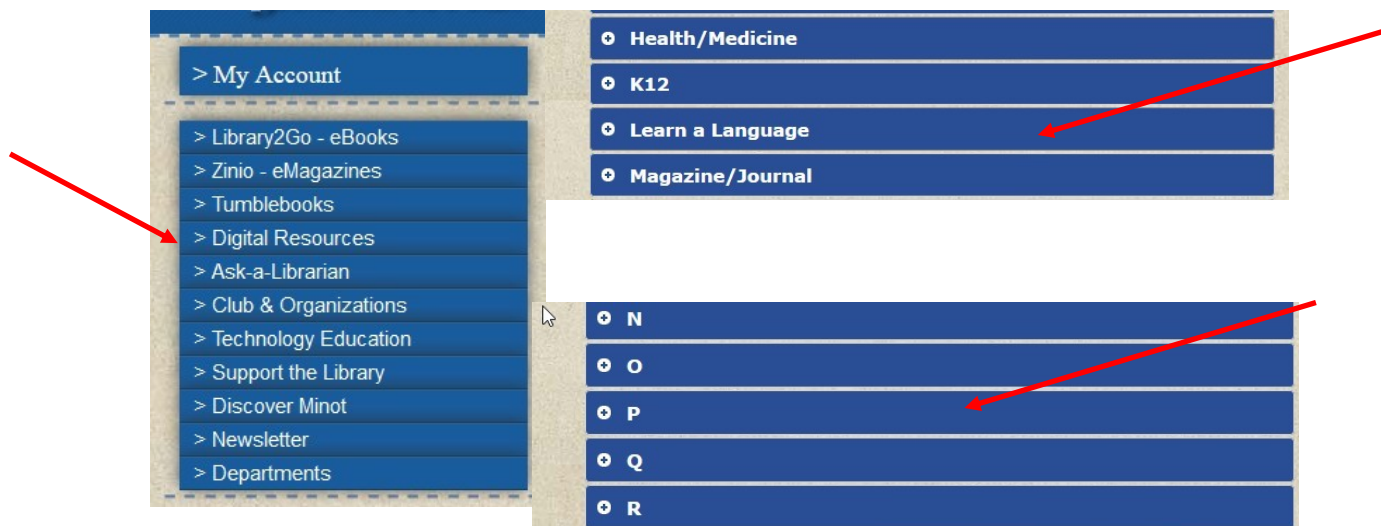


# pronunciator: on a Mobile Device

## (If you haven't registered)

Step 1: On a computer, go to [www.minotlibrary.org](http://www.minotlibrary.org), click on “Digital Resources,” and look for Pronunciator under either *Learn a Language* or the letter P.



Step 2: Register. Type in your card number, click “Register,” and create a profile with an email/username and password.
