






MPL Foot Traffic 2020 vs 2019

On March 16, 2020 the Minot Public Library closed its doors to the public and did not re-open until June 8th. However, to say MPL was "closed" for these 84 days is not accurate.

Of North Dakota libraries serving a population of more than 20,000 the Minot Public Library was the only library to offer curbside services within 24 hours of closing the building.

In addition to curbside, the staff began providing virtual programs and Take & Make activities the same week the Library closed. On November 7th, the Children's Library staff even gave

away 256 LEGO kits and later a LEGO grand prize!

Meanwhile, engagement on Facebook increased by 31% from 41,445 to 54,397. In addition, MPL has 1,169 Instagram followers and is now on TikTok and Animal Crossing!


Sweater Weather Reading Challenge
